Sprinkler Fitters U.A. Local 483 Continuing Education Classes

To sign up for CEC Classes, Download and Use the ISAQR App on your smart phone.

Upgrade classes are **RECOMMENDED** 10 hours per year.

All Licensed Journeymen need 30 hours of approved classes every 3 years.

ASSE 15010 ITM - This is a forty (40 hour) course - This class will guide you through the inspection requirements of NFPA 25 and discuss the installation requirements that are not addressed in NFPA 25. It will also include the testing of systems as required by NFPA 25 and best practices for those systems that lack the documentation to ensure that the required tests are performed. Best practices will be covered under the maintenance requirements, including some tips of the trade. At the end of this course, the attendee will be given the opportunity to get a certification for ITM that includes both a written and practical test that goes beyond the NICET certification. This course will consist of 7 (seven) classes and 1 (one) test day. *CA Approved Course.*

<u>First Aid-</u> This is a four (4 hour) class - First Aid expires after (3) years. *CA Approved Course*. Tuesday, February 6th 4PM-8PM Saturday, February 10th 8AM-12PM

<u>CPR-</u> This is a four (4 hour) class - CPR expires after (1) year. <u>CA Approved Course.</u> Thursday, February 8th 4PM-8PM Saturday, February 10th 12:30PM-4:30PM

<u>Soldering & Brazing-</u> This is a four (4 hour) course. Learn or improve your skills in soldering and brazing. These skills are useful in a variety of applications, including pump rooms and hospital MRI rooms. Wear Boots and Work Clothes. *CA Approved Course.*

Tuesday, February 13th 4PM-8PM

<u>Safe Pressure Testing-</u> This is a four (4 hour) class. This course provides information on different methods for conducting safe pressure testing operations, associated hazards, and necessary precautions. Safety will be the primary focus. Students will identify and demonstrate safe working practices required to successfully plan, perform, and document pressure tests on fire protection systems. <u>Wear Boots and Work Clothes. CA Approved Course.</u>

Thursday, February 22nd 4PM-8PM

<u>Understanding Fire Alarm Devices & Panels-</u> This is a (8 hour) course — This class will give the student a general knowledge of fire alarm circuits and the devices within the fire alarm system that pertain to fire sprinklers. The student will learn the basic concepts of low voltage electricity, fire alarm devices, fire alarm panels and use of a multi- meter in trouble shooting & repairing these systems. <u>Wear Boots and Work Clothes. CA Approved Course.</u>

Saturday, February 24th 8AM-4:30PM

ASSE 12063 - This is a twelve (12 hour) class. This course will train Sprinkler Fitters how to conduct water quality sampling and mapping of fire sprinkler systems. We will cover the fundamentals of water quality management and what our role as sprinkler fitters is in water quality. Applying what we learn in the course to help support the facilities water quality management team. Legionnaire's disease is a very serious type of pneumonia caused by bacteria called Legionella. After completing the course, the sprinkler fitter will know how to conduct a facility risk assessment, implement an accepted water management program and specified testing protocols and acceptable ranges of control measures. CA Approved Course.

Saturday, March 2nd 8AM-4:30PM Tuesday, March 5th TEST 4PM-8PM

<u>Aerial Platform-</u> This is a four (4 hour) class- This course will cover the training that is required by Osha for the operation of AWP's on the jobsite. A Digital card will be issued upon the completion of the class. <u>Wear Boots and Work Clothes.</u> CA Approved Course.

Tuesday, March 12th 4PM-8PM Saturday, March 16th 8AM-12:00PM

<u>Gradall-</u>This is a four (4 hour) course – This course will cover the training required by OSHA for the operation of Gradall/Telehandlers on the jobsite. A Digital card (valid for 3 years) will be issued upon the successful completion of the class. <u>Wear Boots and Work Clothes</u>. *CA Approved Course*.

Thursday, March 14th 4PM-8PM

Saturday, March 16th 12:30PM-4:30PM

<u>Crane Signaling-</u> In this (20 hour) course, students will review, demonstrate, and become certified crane signal persons as required by OSHA in 29 CFR §1926 along with ASME B30.3 and B30.5. Learning activities include a combination of practice scenarios along with animations and videos to illustrate the standard hand signals, and crane characteristics/limitations. Once a certified signal person, one's performance as an examiner will be observed and evaluated with a written and practical exam. During the final day, students will review the computer-delivered UA Signal Person Practical Exam process including how to initiate, administer, and conclude test sessions. <u>Wear Boots and Work Clothes</u>. *CA Approved Course*.
