We hope that you and your guests had a great time at our dinner and if you have any suggestions that you think may help us to improve our dinner program, please feel free to drop us a note.

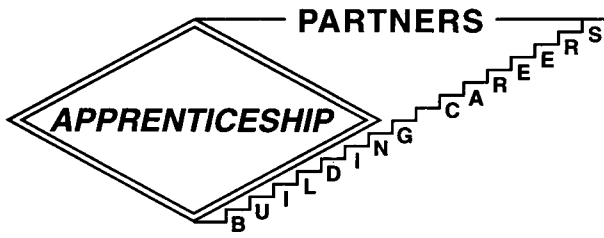

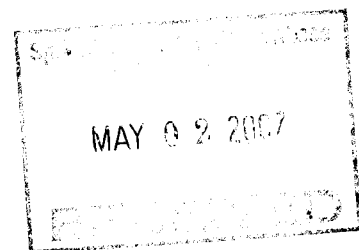
