We want to begin by thanking all of the unions affiliated with the San Mateo County Building Trades Council. Through our unions, hundreds of union construction workers and their families volunteered thousands of hours toward helping our endorsed candidates and ballot measures to be successful on Election Day.

On the local city council and school board elections, Labor in San Mateo County did well. Our friends in Daly City were returned to office. This election was very important to the Building Trades Council because those who oppose development in Daly City supported the opposing candidates. Additionally, those incumbents who opposed Maggie Gomez should get the message that Maggie has the support of the Labor Community and the voters of Daly City, and they should respect and work with her in the future on the City Council. In Menlo Park, the BTC endorsed candidates won, and the incumbents that we supported last time and then wouldn't stand up for union construction were defeated by a huge margin. They came in dead last.

Then there's Pacifica, who once again showed that they do not want development in the Pacifica Quarry. However, we came closer than we have ever come before. Measure L lost by a 48.05% vote Yes to a 51.95% vote No. Maybe if Don Peebles had come to an agreement with the BTC earlier, we might have been able to make a bigger difference. All we can say is that when the next developer comes to town, the BTC will once again offer our support if that developer wants to build an all-union project. Our BTC unions went above and beyond the call of duty to help get Measure L passed. We thank the many volunteers who spent hundreds of hours walking precincts, putting up lawn signs and staffing phone banks. We almost did it. The City Council election in Pacifica was predictable. The voters message: We like the status quo. They re-elected the incumbents Jim Vreeland, Julie Lancelle and Sue Digre. Jim and Julie were endorsed by the BTC. Sue Digre was not.

Again, thanks to everyone for all your hard work. If the rest of California had voted the way San Mateo County voted, Phil Angelides would be our next Governor.
